The Economic Progress Institute has been selected to host a State Policy Fellow who will focus on worker and tribal justice issues.

The State Policy Fellowship program, through the Center on Budget and Policy Priorities (CBPP), is a two-year research-oriented fellowship dedicated to making change through careful research, thoughtful advocacy, and strong partnerships in a state policy context. State Policy Fellows tackle domestic policy challenges in areas including health care, taxes, anti-poverty policy, education, immigration, state-tribal policy, and criminal justice. Working in independent, highly respected policy organizations located across the country, Fellows analyze the impact of state budget and tax policy choices on low-income residents and promote positive reforms.
